The Chamber serves as the primary conduit for information about our community and fulfills thousands of requests for general community, tourist and event information, as well as relocation requests from individuals, families and businesses looking to move to our area. The Chamber provides a critical link between those seeking information and resources within our communities and the agencies, businesses, and organizations that provide those resources.

The Chamber works closely with area businesses and state and local government officials in the development of public policy that may affect business health in Sheridan County. The Chamber provides a public forum for introduction of candidates during an election and hosts an annual legislative forum featuring area legislators prior to each legislative session.

The Chamber plays an active role in economic development in Sheridan County by working closely with Forward Sheridan and other Economic Development Task Force partners to facilitate specific economic development projects. Also, the Chamber Business Retention & Expansion Committee hosts an annual Ignite Your Business Conference each fall and also coordinates year-round, solution-based Ignite Your Business Peer Groups.

For over 20 years, the Chamber has coordinated Leadership Sheridan County (LSC), a county-wide program featuring nine monthly modules on: State Government; Youth Services; City Government; County Government; Health & Social Services; Community History & the Arts; Economic Development; and Natural Resources.

The Chamber fosters communication and collaboration between area businesses, helping to create community synergy through information sharing, leveraging of resources, and the development of business connections. Many networking and learning opportunities exist for area business people, including monthly Chamber luncheons, semi-monthly Chamber coffees, and business after hours events.
